





When most people think of fashion designer Rolando Santana, they do not think of Shriners Hospitals for Children. What people know even less is that as a child Santana was diagnosed with a very mild form of arthrogryposis. Arthrogryposis is the term used to describe congenital joint contractures in two or more areas of the body, typically the hands and feet. While living in Mexico as a small child he received several corrective surgeries to his feet and legs, but was told that he was too young to have his hands operated on. Because of his condition, he spent most of his time wearing special boots, and even learned to walk wearing casts.

Although Santana and his family knew there was something different about his hands and feet, they never treated him any differently. In fact, he lived most of his life not thinking much of his differences. It wasn't until one day Santana and his mother were

riding the bus, and a nurse from Shriners Hospital for Children- Mexico approached them and started asking them questions about

his hands. Nurse Flora, who would later became Santana's nurse, suggested that he go see the doctors at Shriners Hospital about his hands. Only weeks later Santana became a patient and the doctors began providing care to him. In his teenage years he moved to the Mid-Atlantic part of the United States that is when he went to Philadelphia Shriners Hospital to see more specialists, where he underwent several surgeries and procedures to correct his hands.

Fixing Santana's hands did more than give him a better childhood, he considers his experience and the care he received at Shriners Hospitals for Children- Philadelphia a pivotal part of his success and opportunity to follow his dream to become a fashion designer.

"The doctors gave me the ability to use my hands beyond whatever I could have ever imagined, but meeting other kids just like me gave me the strength to overcome my physical challenges. I feel very lucky that Shriners [Hospital] was there for me and a part of my story," said Santana. "For this I will always

be grateful."

Today, Santana is one of New York Fashion scene's most acclaimed fashion designers. He draws his inspiration from his mother, who he spent countless hours observing making dresses, Mexican art as well as many famous artists from around the world. He thrives on always making woman feel beautiful in his collections. "Women, my clients are my fashion muses. They are classic, chic and feminine and I love designing for them, this is my passion!"

Now that Santana's dreams have come true, he wants to make sure he gives back to the place that helped make that happen so many years ago. He recently found time in his busy schedule to come back to Philadelphia Shriners Hospital, where he spent time drawing and sketching fashion designs with the kids. He also talked about his experiences with the children, who are going through similar situations in their lives that he remembers just like yesterday.






