Whereas, Pete graduated from Altoona High School in 1955 and received a degree in Electrical Engineering from Penn State University in 1959. After college, he worked as an Engineering Draftsman for the Navel Research Lab in Washington, DC. He retired as a Maintenance and Engineering Superintendent with Westvaco Corp in Tyrone, PA having served for over 40 years. Pete also had a successful electrical contracting business locally, and

Whereas, he was a member of the following Masonic organizations: Logan Lodge No. 490, Jaffa Shriners, Jaffa Cabiri No. 126, Jaffa Cycle Corps, Altoona Court No. 70 - Royal Order of Jesters and Colotic Miztli No. 91 - Order of Quetzalcoatl. Pete served on the Board of Governors for Shriners Hospitals for Children – Erie and was a former member of the Valley of Altoona - Scottish Rite, Mountain Royal Arch Chapter No. 189, Mountain Council No. 9 and Mountain Commandery No. 10, and

Patient propels in bowling and more despite setbacks

Nathan first started showing symptoms and was losing almost complete use of his right leg and was later diagnosed with Acute Flaccid Myelitis in October 2018. Acute flaccid myelitis (AFM) is a condition that can attack the nervous tissue and the myelin of the spine nerves. This can result in weakness and loss of function.

Nathan is 16 years old, and his love for golf and bowling propels his ambitions in school. Both of his arms were also affected by his AFM, which hit him hard because of how much he loved—and how good he was at—bowling.

Jay, Nathan's dad, said: "When we first heard of Shriners Hospital, we didn't know that it would become our home

for everything." They were receiving care at other facilities, but they felt that all of their needs weren't being met. Nathan has since found a home here with Joshua Pahys, M.D., orthopaedic surgeon, for his scoliosis treatment.

When thinking back on the start of his scoliosis treatment, he remembered going to the Motion Analysis Center (MAC). The MAC lab uses a motion-capture camera system to track the movements of patients like Nathan as they walk, reach, bend and twist. Using our technology, we help physicians and therapists determine if a child will benefit from surgery, rehabilitation, and/or orthotic braces. Nathan was able to bring in his bowling ball and golf club in hand to test his range of motion while doing the activities he loves.



Because of the care, he has received for his scoliosis and AFM, he's still able to compete in bowling tournaments competitively. In early July, he was in Detroit, MI, for the "Teen Masters," an ambitious tournament for K-12 and college students. "It's just great to still be able to compete even with everything going on," Nathan said.

PROPOSED CHANGE TO BY-LAWS

ARTICLE 6, SUB SECTION 6.2 DUES

Due to the anticipated increase of Shriners International per capita tax at the 2022 Imperial session of at least \$30 and the declining member here at the Jaffa Shrine, the Divan is recommending an increase in dues to \$150 annually beginning January 2023.

The last increase was in 2016 and was a per capita increase and not an increase to the dues. As cost to maintain our beautiful building are constantly increasing, we find it necessary to raise the dues to the Nobles.

This is the first reading of the proposed change. The next reading will be at the Fall Business Meeting in November and the approval will be at the Business Meeting in January.

Bids for Kids Donates over \$63,000 to SHC — Erie

Erie Shriners Jammers Wrap Up 2021 Season

The Shriners Hospitals for Children — Erie wheelchair basketball team, Erie Shriners Jammers, recently finished their 2021 season. The program, which began about 15 years ago, offers many benefits to patients, including increased self confidence, learning to be part of a team and learning to play by the rules.

This year's season was five weeks long. Each Wednesday, players met on the basketball court behind the medical center to practice skills in ma-

neuvering the sport wheelchairs and basketball skills, followed by a game. Each player received an Erie Shriners Jammers t-shirt and refreshments were provided after each game.



Game, Set, Match for Christian

Christian raises his left arm and tosses a ball into the air, followed by the tennis racket in his right arm that sends it sailing over the net. Thanks to the help of the limb deficiency medical team and Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services — Northeast, LLC (POPS), at Shriners Hospitals for Children — Erie, he can now serve a tennis ball with power and precision.

Christian was born with a left arm that was much shorter than his right. He began receiving care at Shriners Hospitals for Children — Erie when he was a baby and had his first of many arm-lengthening surgeries when he was four years old. He then followed with intermittent occupational therapy through the years, primarily focused on self-care.

Christians SHC — Erie journey did not end there. It was just recently that Christian decided to return to the medical center to be fitted for a prosthesis. He never had a desire to wear one in the past, but his tennis coach suggested that it might improve his

game by allowing him to better serve the ball and have more power behind his serve. He attended the limb deficiency clinic and began working with Occupational Therapist, Emily Madder, MS, OTR/L and POPS Prosthetist, Alex Betancourt, MS, CPO to design a device that allows him to toss the ball up with his left arm and hit it with his right. "They knew what to do right away," said Christian. "They fix problems," he added, "If a kid says 'I can't do that,' they find a way to make it work. They are amazing and encouraging."



At 14 years old, Christian already has big plans for his future. He wants to own land and be either a realtor, engineer or lawyer. "I always want to improve," he says, "I don't feel good when I don't. I also want to prove to people that I can be just as good as them." Wherever the future takes him, his determination and positive attitude will surely help him succeed both on and off the tennis court.

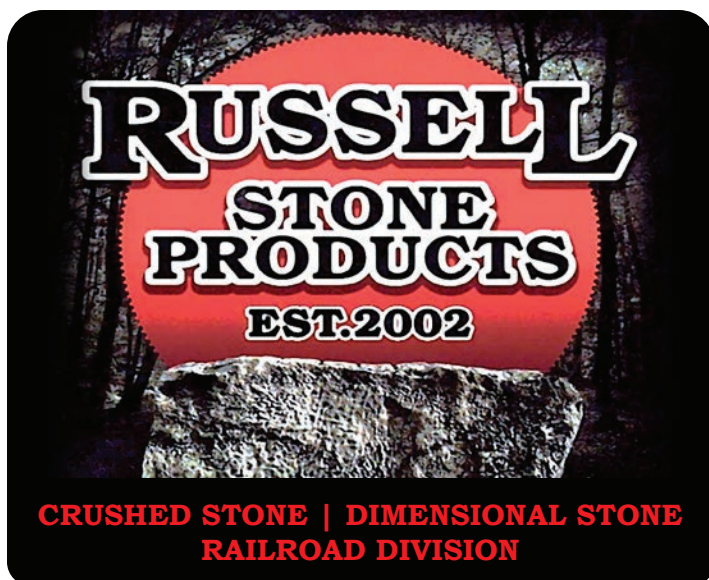

Julia, 20, a patient at Shriners Hospitals for Children — Philadelphia, will have the experience of a lifetime when she represents the local Shriners care location at the Shriners Children's Open, an official PGA tour event in Las Vegas this October. Julia grew up in Altoona, Pennsylvania, with her parents and siblings. She comes from a close family who is rich in faith.

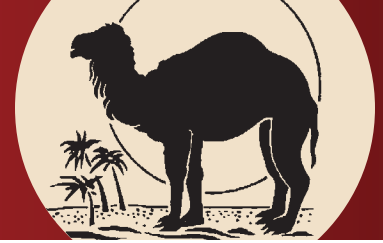

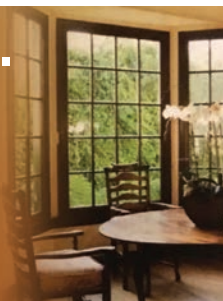
