



A Shriners Children's Erie Update





More than \$18,000 raised during annual telethon

Shriners Children's Erie hosted their annual TV Telethon with JET24/F0X66 Tuesday, March 22 at the Millcreek Mall. Thank you to all the staff, Board members and Shriners who participated to make the event successful. They were able to raise over \$17,000 and reach a combined audience of 106,758 people, with a \$49,084 value of television coverage.

In addition to the funds raised, the powerful stories of care shared with the Erie community are just as valuable.

Scoliosis patient standing tall thanks to Shriners Children's Erie

Four-year-old Logan was eager to start preschool, but before he could enter the classroom he had to get a physical. On the day of his physical appointment, the doctor asked Logan to bend over and touch his toes. It was then that the doctor first noted Logan's spine was crooked. They found the curve of Logan's spine was around 30° at the top and 20° at the bottom with rotation in between.

Today, thanks to the care received at Shriners Logan is a healthy, happy 18-year-old!



After Logan's diagnosis, the doctors told Sherry her son was not expected to live past 20 years of age. They explained that the rotation of his spine could impact his lungs and other important organs. "You don't want anybody to ever tell you, you are going to outlive your children," said Sherry.

Determined, she sought out other options and began attending a scoliosis support group with other families who have experience with scoliosis. A fellow mother of the group referred Sherry to Shriners Children's.

"Shriners was so wonderful with Logan and our whole family," said Sherry, "They answered questions no matter how silly we thought they were. "Shriners Children's made sure Logan's questions were heard and answered, all while supporting mom's concerns along the way.

After traveling the distance from Ohio to Shriners Children's Erie for 14 years, the providers and staff became like a second family to Logan and his loved ones.

Through the years, Logan underwent many treatments and procedures including three years of Mehta casting, a tethered release procedure and a spinal fusion, where he received 27 rods and pins in his spine.

Logan is now a senior at Newton Falls High School in Ohio, playing varsity basketball and running track. Upon asking Logan's mother what it was like to see her son thriving in the activities that he loves, she became emotional as any loving mother would, saying, "It's the most wonderful thing I ever could imagine, I never thought that he would be in this place where he is living a normal life and enjoying all the things."

Logan visited Shriners Children's Erie for the last time earlier this year standing two inches taller with his corrected spine. He is interested in furthering his education by studying computer repair and programming, hopes to pick up club basketball and possibly have the opportunity to coach kids who enjoy staying active just like he has.

From being a young boy with a very crooked spine to a man pursuing his dreams, Logan's experience with scoliosis serves as a reminder that you can overcome anything you set your mind to, with proper guidance from professionals like those at Shriners Children's, a loving family's support and determination.



Myles gets his first prosthesis — patient finds daily activities easier with new prosthetic arm

Myles is a smart, helpful 8-year-old from Kearny, New Jersey. He was born without his right arm and has mastered every task for which most people think you need two hands.

But Myles was recently at Shriners Children's Philadelphia to be fitted for a prosthetic arm, even with all the ways that he has adapted living without one. "I didn't think he'd want one, since he was born like that," said Christine, Myles' mom. "But he brought up wanting one to help hold things, and of course play video games."

While it's easy enough for Myles to press the A, B, X and Y buttons with his foot while he plays video games, for certain systems and controllers, it's easier to hold it with a prosthesis and press the buttons with his left hand.

Although he was fitted for his first prosthesis recently, Myles isn't a new patient. He had hand surgery to move a ligament from his ring finger to his thumb in July 2019 to help with grip strength. "It's also just not about the great care," explained Christine. "It's how everyone at Shriners [Children's] treats him so well. There are also oth-



er kids like him and it feels like a community whenever we are here."

Myles was excited at his appointment and was thinking about all the things he wanted to do. But when asked, one answer was clearly at the top of his list: "I want to help mom with the groceries!"

He also mentioned wanting to be able to hold paper better while cutting it for arts and crafts. Another plus that his mom shared was riding his bike with more stability! He summed his appointment up simply. "It's nice to come here. I'm excited to get my new prosthesis."

POTENTIAL DUES CHANGES

Fellow Nobles,

As one of your elected representatives to Shriners International, I felt it was important to communicate potential changes to our dues structure.

Our current dues structure breakdown is as follows:

\$30 - Per Capita (Shriners International)

\$5 - Hospital Levy (Shriners Children's)

\$55 - Temple Dues (Jaffa Shriners)

\$90 - Total

At the next Imperial Session, it is believed that an increase from Shriners International will be passed to raise Per Capita from \$30 to \$50. This change will affect the life dues calculation in the future.

I wanted to communicate this to make you aware that life dues are still being accepted by Shriners International, Shriners Children's and Jaffa Shriners. What will change, is the cost for each of these.

Here is how the current life dues structure is broken down:

\$30/year x 30 years = \$900 (Per Capital Life Member "PCLM") - Shriners International \$5/year x 30 years = \$150 (Permanent Contributing Member "PCM") - Shriners Children's \$55/year x 20 years = \$1,100 (Jaffa Life Membership) \$2,150 = Total Life Membership (TLM)

Next year's life membership breakdown (if everything is approved as anticipated):

\$50/year x 30 years = \$1,500 (Per Capital Life Member "PCLM") - Shriners International \$5/year x 30 years = \$150 (Permanent Contributing Member "PCM") - Shriners Children's \$95/year x 20 years = \$1,900 (Jaffa Life Membership). \$3,550 = Total Life Membership (TLM)

I present this information to you so you may consider getting a life membership in anyone of the three classifications that make up our dues structure. You can do one, two or all three. The Jaffa Nobility already approved the increase from \$55 to \$95 for 2023 Jaffa dues at the Annual Meeting in January 2022. You can still purchase a Jaffa Life Membership for the lower rate of \$1,100 until July 31, 2022. August 1, 2022 starts the next dues (2023) year in which case the new life dues would be \$1,900.

You can still purchase a Per Capita Life Membership for the lower rate of \$900 until July 31, 2022. August 1, 2022 starts the next dues (2023) year in which case the new life dues would be \$1,500.

If you are interested in any of these life memberships at the lower rates, here is what you need to do: Write out one, two or three checks in the amounts below to "Jaffa Shriners" and in the memo section note which life membership you are paying for.

\$900 - PCLM \$150 - PCM \$1,100 - Jaffa Life Membership
