





**COSTS FOR MEMBERS AND CANDIDATES:** Candidates will pay a \$30 total event fee that includes all the cost associated with the event. This will be billed to the lodge they have joined and can be reversed to the candidate if the lodge so desires. Non Scottish Rite participants will pay \$10 to the Valley of Altoona for the luncheon. The evening meal will be courtesy of the Jaffa Shrine. *All costs may be subject to change.* 

Dear Nobles, Brethren, and Potential Candidates within the 20th Masonic District,

With the One Day Masonic Journey in March, there are some points of interest I would like to share with you. All petitions are to be handled in the traditional way, read one month, laid over for investigation and balloted on the following month. All petitions will need acted upon no later than the March Stated Meetings. That means you will need your petitions turned in by February Stated Meeting! If you have a candidate from a different Masonic District, you will need the permission of your District Deputy Grand Master, and they will, in turn, contact Lawrence J. Bilotto, District Deputy Grand Master of the 20th Masonic District.

The Lodge Secretary will be responsible for registering your Lodge's candidates that day. If for any reason he is unable to attend that day, you will need to have someone fill in for him and perform the duties that day. Sign-in sheets and candidate packets will already be there. The Lodge Secretary will be responsible for entering the candidate's information after final confirmation received from the Coordinator that he was present for all degrees.

The candidate will need to bring an approval letter with him to the Jaffa Shrine. The Lodge Secretary should make a copy

and take it with him just in case a candidate forgets it. I'm sure it will happen to someone. In our Lodge we are inviting the candidates and their mentors to our Brother's Breakfast to inform them what is going happen that day, what he will need to gain entrance (Approval letter & Photo I.D.) and how to dress. A meeting like this can be held at your Lodge's convenience and would be a good idea. The Grand Master requires one mentor for a candidate. There is a place on the approval letter for the mentor's name.

The mentors will be instructed on the steps, signs and grips and words. The mentor's instruction will be between each degree in the 22nd Street Lounge. Additionally there will be instruction provided at the 20th Masonic District, School of Instruction.

As a member you may be asking what you can do to help. Please go to your lodge's February Stated Meeting and let your Secretary know that you would like help with the One Day Class. I imagine all the lodges are scrambling to find mentors. This is the must go-to Masonic Event of the year. There will be a luncheon available and a dinner after the Scottish Rite and Shriners International rituals and ceremonies are completed.

Registration begins at 6:00 AM on Saturday morning, March 25, 2023 at the Jaffa Shrine Center. Get out to your Lodges, see how you can help, and attend this event.

# How to access the Shriners Village Boardroom

On October 13, 2021, Shriners International released the new shrinersinternational.org website. Upon this release, attempts to access Shriners Village are now redirected to shrinersinternational.org. As a result, and as explained below, the Shriners Village Boardrooms will now be accessed through a link on the new site.

The new shrinersinternational.org site includes a Member Center that allows nobles to view their Shrine membership information, update their contact information, view a digital version of their membership card and access member only content. The Member Center Dashboard contains the link to the Boardrooms. This link will only be available to those nobles authorized to access the Boardrooms.

You can access the new Member Center by going to www.shrinersinternational.org and clicking on the Login option in the upper right (desktop) or at the bottom of the screen (mobile – portrait mode). The new Member Center uses the same credentials as WebFez. If you have a WebFez login, use the same username and password to login to the Member Center.



If you don't have a WebFez login, click Create an Account with ShrineID and follow the instructions to set up an account.

Please have your membership card handy as you will need to enter your Shrine ID. Once registered, you will be able to use this username and password to login to both the Member Center and WebFez.

Once you have logged into the Member Center, your Dashboard page will be displayed. If you have Boardroom access, the link will appear on the right side of the page (desktop) or by scrolling down the page (mobile).

# ILLUSTRIOUS SIR CHESTER H. PRIBBLE

JUNE 7, 1924 - OCTOBER 10, 2022



Whereas, on Monday, October 10, 2022, the Supreme Architect of the Universe sent the black camel, which carried our esteemed brother, Illustrious Sir Chester H. "Chet" Pribble to his eternal reward, and

Whereas, that great architect in his infinite wisdom, called our exalted Masonic brother, devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and businessman from his Earthly labors to rest in that home on high, not made by hands, eternal in the heavens, and

Whereas, his untiring efforts, unswerving loyalty and devotion to his Fraternity earned him the esteem and admiration of his brothers and his passing will leave an everlasting void in the minds and hearts of all the Nobility, and as Potentate of Jaffa Shriners in 1973 his sound judgement and safe counsel were invaluable resources to all of the Nobles of Jaffa Temple, and

Whereas, he was born in Petroleum, West Virginia, son of the late Sherman and Ella Pribble. Chet married Elizabeth Ellen Long of Milton in 1950 and enjoyed 69 years of marriage. He is survived by his three children: daughter Lynne Caskey, and her husband Joe; daughter, Nancy Wert, and her husband Ron; and son, Randall Pribble, and his wife Barbara. He leaves behind four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren, and

Whereas, Chet was a 1942 graduate of Lock Haven High School. In 1943 Chester enlisted in the United States Army and served with the 164th Combat Engineer Battalion. He spent time in England, France, Germany, and Belgium during his two and a half years of service. Chester attained the rank of NCO Technical Sargent. After the war, Chester enrolled at Philadelphia College of Textiles and Science. He later graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Textile Engineering. While at textile college, Chester was the president of the Phi Si Textile Fraternity. In 1950, Chet started his career at Woolrich, Incorporated. He was a lover of everything Woolrich and spent his entire working career of 39 years at Woolrich. He retired in 1989 as Vice President of Apparel Manufacturing, serving on the Woolrich board of Directors from 1958 to 1989, and

Whereas, he was a Freemason for over 70 years in La Fayette Lodge No. 199 in Lock Haven, Pennsylvania. Chet was also a member of the following Masonic organizations: 32° Scottish Rite Freemason in the Valley of Williamsport – AASR, Jaffa Shriners, Jaffa Cabiri No. 106, Altoona Court No. 70 - Royal Order of Jesters, and


