

A Shriners Children's Erie Update



### New Knee Offers Flexibility for Active Teenager

Yandel was born with proximal femoral focal deficiency (PFFD), a birth defect in which the upper part of the femur is either malformed or missing, causing one leg to be shorter than the other. He began receiving care at a young age at Shriners Children's Erie where he and his physician, Sarah Nossov, MD, decided that a transfemoral prosthesis may help him to lead a more functional life. Over the years, Yandel has gained confidence and increased his activity level and the types of activities he participates in. He is a wrestler, weightlifter and is experimenting with other sports such as running, cheerleading and football. Unfortunately, with all his new activities. Yandel felt that his prosthesis was no longer "keeping up with him."

In late 2022, Yandel met with the team at Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS) at Shriners Children's Erie, to see how they could help him. Hannah Clark, CPO, evaluated Yandel Within a few hours of



training, Yandel walked down stairs, stepover-step, for the first time. He was also able to try "cycle mode" in the physical therapy gym. Samantha Fields, DPT, physical and decided that he would be an excellent candidate for a microprocessor knee, due to his understanding of his body mechanics, responsible nature, abil-

ity to care for and maintain his prosthesis and regular "wearing out" of his current device. After selecting an appropriate knee for Yandel, Hannah got certified in the use, programming and provision of the specific knee and invited a representative from the manufacturer to attend the socket fitting and initial knee programming appointment. Yandel was fitted for the knee and his initial response was "It feel just like a real leg."

The team at Shriners Children's Erie is excited to see what the future holds for this active and determined young man. "We can't wait to see what he decides to conquer next and are honored to support him every step of the way," said Clark. therapist at Shriners Children's Erie and Kristie Gunn, Rehab Aide, helped position him on the bike and he almost instinctively began riding! After a few minutes of riding, Yandel was overcome with emotion and hugged his mom. His dad commented, "17 years. For 17 years my boy has never been able to ride a bike. This is amazing!"

### Patient ambassador Ally to represent Shriners Children's Philadelphia at the Shriners Children's College Classic

A Patient Ambassador and former softball player, Ally was recently selected to represent the University of Michigan baseball team as an honorary team captain in the upcoming Shriners Children's College Classic in Houston, Texas.



Ally met the team last fall, and is traveling to Houston to represent them in the Shriners Children's College Classic. The three-day, sixteam, nine-game event continues to draw fans, top-ranked programs and scouts from every Major League organization each year.

Ally first came to Shriners Children's Philadelphia in August 2017 after hearing about Shriners Children's from her grandfather, who was also a Shriner. As suspected, she was diagnosed with scoliosis, which led to surgery a few months later in October. After her first vertebral body tethering surgery, Ally grew five inches and had a lot of flexibility to play softball and participate in many other physical activities for most of her high school career. From the beginning, Ally said that the hospital feels like a second home and that her family had made the right decision.

"Shriners makes me feel like I'm not at a hospital and makes feel like I'm at home," said Ally. "We knew right from the start that I was in the best hands."

Although Ally had to return to Shriner Children's Philadelphia in 2022 for a second spinal surgery, she was still very satisfied with her choice of care and doctor, orthopedic surgeon Steven Hwang, M.D.

"With both surgeries, I was never scared or had any anxiety because I knew I was in the best hands. I wouldn't want my spinal fusion done anywhere else," said Ally. "I love Dr. Hwang—he will be my doctor forever!"

Ally also has a very good relationship with the Detroit Moslem Shriners in Novi, Michigan, near her hometown. Ally and her parents are very grateful for all the help and support the Shriners have provided. In addition to helping with all of Ally's trips to the Philadelphia Shriners Hospital, they were also instrumental in helping Ally to have an opportunity to represent the hospital at the Shriners Children's College Classic.

"I am extremely excited and honored to represent the Philadelphia Hospital and the Detroit Shriners, said Ally. "It gives me the opportunity to show a different type of patient. I look normal, but I have hard times too."



### Rare Disease Day 2023: Kiera's journey at Shriner's Children's

When Jessica and her husband, Aaron, went to the doctor for their 20-week anatomy scan, they found that their daughter would be born without her left arm at the shoulder. After taking the necessary time to process, they determined a care plan for after birth. When she was two months old, Keira had her first visit with Scott Kozin, M.D., chief of staff.

One year later the family noticed that Keira's back was tight but thought it may have been because of her condition and lack of left arm. Raising their concerns at a follow-up appointment, they were sent for spinal X-rays. Josh Pahys, M.D., determined that Keira also had progressive infantile scoliosis. Within hours, the team set her up with an immediate treatment plan.

Keira's initial treatment plan for her scoliosis included spinal cord detethering surgery and mehta casting. After a series of about 12 casts, it was time to switch to a Wilmington brace, which she continues to wear today. Another convenience for the family is the on-site pediatric orthotics and prosthetic department.

Now in first grade, Keira loves sports, drawing, singing, music and swimming.



# Jakka Temple, Altoona, Pennsylvania A.A.O.A.M.S.

This short historical account of Jaffa Temple contains only the highlights up to the year 1973, when Jaffa celebrated its 76th Anniversary.

From the seed planted October 3, 1903 when Jaffa Temple, A.A.O.N.M.S. was instituted, with Altoona, Pennsylvania, designated as its Oasis, the fledgling has grown—its branches have spread, until today it ranks among the largest and most active Temples of the 174 Temples in North America.

The Temple began with 164 Charter Members, and a class of 213 novices, for a total of 377 Nobles on the day it was constituted. As of December 31, 1974, Jaffa Membership reached the total of 7,382 members.

The dream of forming a temple began to unfold late in the 19th century—among many Nobles who held memberships in other temples, especially Syria of Pittsburgh, Pa. By 1902, approximately 200 Nobles who held membership in Syria Temple, Pittsburgh, Pa. and residing in Altoona—and it was this group which in September 1902 met in Pittsburgh, and formed a Shrine Club. On October 23, 1902 when Syria Mosque was dedicated, Syria Nobles from Altoona who were present for the ceremonial organized the Altoona Shrine Club.

From this group, a dream of a temple in Altoona started to show realism, and by July 9, 1903 the Charter for the temple, located in Altoona, Penna. was granted.

The newly constituted temple had no permanent home. At first meetings were held in the Murry Building—later the office was moved to the Masonic Temple, where meetings were held. All Ceremonial Sessions were conducted in the East Side Theater.

By 1909 the need for a permanent home became more apparent. On September 10, 1909 the cornerstone was placed in the erection of a new Temple, located at 709-11 Chestnut Avenue, and it was dedicated August 25, 1910.

As Jaffa's membership grew, the temple on Chestnut Avenue got smaller, so the need for a larger temple became apparent. After acquiring a new site, ground for a new Mosque was broken June 28,1928. Potentate William G. Munn, father of the present Recorder presided, and Recorder Wilson A. Turner, turned the first shovel of earth.

The new Jaffa Mosque was dedicated September 25, 1930—celebrating 27 years of growth and development. Many dignitaries and Units from other Shrine Temples attended the ceremonies.

Although a few minor changes have been made, basically the Mosque has not been changed since its dedication.

For a period of several years during the great depression, like all other Shrine Temples, Jaffa experienced financial and membership problems, but the Temple was able to survive, and came back strong.

During the 51 years the Shriners Hospitals, and now the Burn Centers have been operating, Jaffa Temple has always contributed its share to this great movement, so also have the Uniformed Units of Jaffa Temple.






