# Changing the Game: Adaptive Sports

Adaptive sports, modified to fit the needs of the athlete, allow individuals to continue to do what they love.

Like many of our patients, Steven has grown up coming to Shriners Children's Philadelphia since the age of 5. He was diagnosed with transverse myelitis, a neurological disorder caused by inflammation to both sides of a section of the spinal cord. In Steven's situation, the inflammation occurred in his cervical spine.

Due to his condition, Steven has impaired strength and sensation throughout his arms and legs. This is defined as incomplete quadriplegia (tetraplegia). After making the switch from playing wheelchair basketball three years ago, Steven began playing wheelchair rugby through the Magee Rehabilitation Program, and he has loved it ever since.



While he was a patient, Steven worked with our team of physical therapists, where sports-specific training was a part of his care plan.

"His goals were to get stronger for his sport and with his upper extremity strength and range of motion limitations; he needed the specialization/skill set of a physical therapist to adapt his strength training movements." Says, Christin Krey, PT, MPT, PCS.

"Ms. Christin was my therapist in my later years there, and she really set the tone and helped develop a workout schedule for back at home, which has paid off tons! Everyone I've worked with was amazing. All of the therapists always found a way to mix in some fun with the work, which always made the session much more enjoyable and made me eager to work!" said Steven.

# Richard receives the BEAR Implant Surgery

It was a typical day for Richard playing basketball with his friends until a sports injury brought his game to an abrupt halt. As a rising junior in high school and an athlete who swims backstroke competitively on the high school and club team, an anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) tear was not expected.

After an initial visit with his pediatrician, X-rays and an MRI, Richard was referred to Shriners Children's Philadelphia to have his ACL examined. He visited with Sean Waldron, M.D., pediatric orthopedic surgeon, for a consultation, and it was determined that surgery would be the best option to repair the torn ligament.

With traditional ACL repairs, there are a few different surgical repair techniques, all of which were explained during the appointment. After hearing the options presented to him, Richard chose to proceed with the new innovative ACL repair option, the BEAR Implant surgery. He felt this was his best option for a faster and easier recovery versus typical ACL surgery. Richard was the first Shriners Children's Philadelphia patient to undergo this procedure.



The BEAR Implant is the first medical advancement granted approval from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration that enables the body to heal its own torn ACL. This new approach is a paradigm shift from ACL reconstruction, and is the first innovation in ACL tear treatment in more than 30 years.

"I was kind of scared at first, but I'm healing incredibly well, and within three weeks of surgery I was already able to bend my knee at 90 degrees." - Richard, Philadelphia

The BEAR Implant allows patients to heal quicker and return to doing what they love much faster, and does not require a second surgery. "I am excited to have the opportunity to offer this ground-breaking technique to the pediatric athletes in our area," said Dr. Waldron.

While Richard may be supporting his teammates from the sidelines this upcoming swim season, he is hopeful for a full return to the sport when he is fully recovered.

"Richard is making excellent progress! He was able to attend PT prior to his surgery ("pre-hab"), which was extremely beneficial for his leg strength. Usually, the hardest part for athletes is being patient to allow themselves time to heal and progress safely to the next stage. He will be back in the pool as soon as he's ready!" said Sarah.





# WebFez Information

As we try to improve our communication efforts, Jaffa will be sending a monthly information email via WebFez. I have included an attachment to show how to register in WebFez. Once you have registered, you will be able to check your records to make sure your address, telephone, email and shrine records are correct. # How to access the Shriners Village Boardroom

On October 13, 2021, Shriners International released the new shrinersinternational.org website. Upon this release, attempts to access Shriners Village are now redirected to shrinersinternational.org. As a result, and as explained below, the Shriners Village Boardrooms will now be accessed through a link on the new site.

The new shrinersinternational.org site includes a Member Center that allows nobles to view their Shrine membership information, update their contact information, view a digital version of their membership card and access member only content. The Member Center Dashboard contains the link to the Boardrooms. This link will only be available to those nobles authorized to access the Boardrooms.

You can access the new Member Center by going to www.shrinersinternational.org and clicking on the Login option in the upper right (desktop) or at the bottom of the screen (mobile – portrait mode). The new Member Center uses the same credentials as WebFez. If you have a WebFez login, use the same username and password to login to the Member Center.



If you don't have a WebFez login, click Create an Account with ShrineID and follow the instructions to set up an account.

Please have your membership card handy as you will need to enter your Shrine ID. Once registered, you will be able to use this username and password to login to both the Member Center and WebFez.

Once you have logged into the Member Center, your Dashboard page will be displayed. If you have Boardroom access, the link will appear on the right side of the page (desktop) or by scrolling down the page (mobile).

Once you click the link, you will be redirected to the Shriners Village login page. You will need to login using your Shriners Village credentials. After logging in, you will be taken to the Boardrooms.




