In 2007 items can be dropped off to any Nile member. the Daughters of the Nile Foundation was formed to help distribute the contributions to the Shriners In December, we welcomed three new members Kathy Hospitals. SAMSAR AWARDS

ABOUT THE SAMSAR AWARD

SAMSAR is derivative from the Sanskrit (official language in India) word Samsāra which is the repeating cycle of birth, life, death, and re-birth. It is also used to describe one's actions and consequences in the past, present, and future in Hinduism, Buddhism, Bon, Jainism, Taoism, and Sikhism.



The SAMSAR award was established to encourage membership in our fraternity. These awards are presented to nobles who have been active in recruiting new members for Jaffa Temple. SAMSAR Awards are presented at each Jaffa Ceremonial.

HOW POINTS ARE ACCUMULATED

Awards are based on points accumulated over a period of years. In order to become a member of Jaffa, a petition for membership must be completed, along with two signatures of current members. One is called a top line signer and the other a second line signer. You receive SAMSAR points based on being a top line or a second line signer. First line signers of Affiliation and Reinstatement Nobles also received points.

- 75 points A top line signer on a Shrine petition
- 25 points A second line signer on a Shrine petition
- 25 points A top line signer for each Affiliation to Jaffa
- 25 points A top line signer for each Reinstatement in Jaffa

In addition to accumulating points towards your SAMSAR jewel and attachments, you can receive symbols representing the number of petitions you have signed. For your first petition that you signed on the top line, you received 75 points toward your SAMSAR jewel plus a CAMEL lapel pin. For your second petition, you will receive a TASSEL holder for your fez and a jeweled numeral 2 to attach to this tassel holder, representing the fact you were a top line signer on two petitions. For each additional shrine petition that you sign on the top line, you received a jeweled numeral representing the number of petitions that you have signed.

HOW TO ACCESS

The Shriners Village Boardroom

On October 13, 2021, Shriners International released the new shrinersinternational.org website. Upon this release, attempts to access Shriners Village are now redirected to shrinersinternational.org. As a result, and as explained below, the Shriners Village Boardrooms will now be accessed through a link on the new site.

The new shrinersinternational.org site includes a Member Center that allows nobles to view their Shrine membership information, update their contact information, view a digital version of their membership card and access member only content. The Member Center Dashboard contains the link to the Boardrooms. This link will only be available to those nobles authorized to access the Boardrooms.

You can access the new Member Center by going to www.shrinersinternational.org and clicking on the Login option in the upper right (desktop) or at the bottom of the screen (mobile – portrait mode). The new Member Center uses the same credentials as WebFez. If you have a WebFez login, use the same username and password to login to the Member Center.

Please have your membership card handy as you will need to enter your Shrine ID. Once registered, you will be able to use this username and password to login to both the Member Center and WebFez.

Once you have logged into the Member Center, your Dashboard page will be displayed. If you have Boardroom access, the link will appear on the right side of the page (desktop) or by scrolling down the page (mobile).

Members with boardroom access you can now follow this link.

Once you click the link, you will be redirected to the Shriners Village login page. You will need to login using your Shriners Village credentials. After logging in, you will be taken to the Boardrooms.

WEBFEZ INFORMATION



As we try to improve our communication efforts, Jaffa will be sending a monthly information email via WebFez. I have included an attachment to show how to register in WebFez. Once you have registered, you will be able to check your records to make sure your address, telephone, email and shrine records are correct. This will ensure that you are getting the information concerning upcoming activities and special meetings that might be of interest to you.

It will be every noble's responsibility to make sure their email address is correct. If you do not have an email account, I would ask some to make sure they are passing along the information. I would also encourage you to include your significant other's email address. That way, they are aware of what is going on and can help you keep track of important dates. Should you need help setting up your WebFez account, contact the Jaffa office or Jim Miller.

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the Register button on the Login page.
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Shrine ID (found on your membership card) and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.




